**Online Safety:**

DJ School UK has made the online safety of all our students the top priority in developing this offer. If the student DJ is under 18 you will be sent our Online Safety Policy and will need to sign and return online teaching consent agreements for the student and the parent/carer (copies of the consent agreements and policy are available via a link at the end of this document).

**Fees:**

Beginners course – for people with no DJ equipment and no DJ experience: £95  
\*please see requirements for the beginners course below.

Includes – 4 basic tuition videos for Free DJ software and 3 \* 30 min video calls with your tutor. (please note – the first video call will be used to check you have everything set up for online learning. You will only be charged for the course after this session if you confirm you want to go ahead.)

A flat fee of £30 per 30 minute video call. Please discuss what you want to know in advance with your tutor so you get maximum learning for your money.

**Payment:** We will provide your first zoom session before payment. If you aren't happy with the session there is no fee. We do this so we can confirm that everything is set up correctly at your end and so that you can check that learning online works for you. If you want to continue we arrange payment for the first session afterwards. Any follow up sessions are paid for in advance when confirming your booking. Payments are preferred via Paypal but we also accept Bank Transfers via BACS.

\*Requirements for the beginners course:

If you are under 18 and want to take our course for total beginners you will need:

- a computer that can be placed in a safe part of your house according to our online safety policy (not a bedroom or bathroom).
- that computer to meet the minimum system requirements so it can have free dj software downloaded onto it. See the bottom of this document for internet links regarding this.
- that computer to meet the minimum system requirements so it can have free Zoom video calling software downloaded onto it. See the bottom of this email for internet links regarding this.
- that computer to have some music on it for DJing with ( we can help with this too).
- an adult available who will make sure DJs are logging onto the right videos.
- an adult who will set up and log in each Zoom online lesson and stay within earshot during each session.
