

DJ School UK Online Safety Agreement for Young People.

DJ School UK understands the importance of children and young people being able to use the internet for education and personal development. This includes social media platforms, games and apps.

DJ School UK will mostly deliver online lessons by sharing pre-prepared videos. Sometimes we will use face to face video conferencing apps and in some cases we may use social media platforms (eg soundcloud, youtube).

We recognise that while conducting online work with any young people, safeguards need to be in place to ensure they are kept safe at all times.

We also see online work as an opportunity to help young people learn how to stay safe on the internet. We will promote good practice wherever we can.

This agreement is part of our overarching code of behaviour for children/young people, staff and volunteers and relates to our safeguarding and child protection policy. Both documents can be found along with all our policies and terms at: <u>https://djschooluk.org.uk/policies/</u>

Young person: please read the following agreement and discuss it with your parents/carers and Online DJ tutor(s).

Parents/carers: please read and discuss this agreement with your child and then sign it, ask your child to sign it, and return it to DJ School UK.



Young person's agreement

- ! I will be responsible for my behaviour when using the internet, including social media platforms, games and apps. This includes the resources I access and the language I use.
- ! I will not deliberately browse, download or upload material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material I will report it immediately to my parent/carer and/or online DJ tutor.
- ! I will not send anyone material that could be considered threatening, bullying, offensive or illegal.
- ! I will not share or redistribute any content from my DJ School UK sessions.
- ! I will only communicate with DJ School UK using the platforms and apps agreed by my parent/carers.
- ! I will not give out any personal information online, such as my name, phone number or address.
- ! I will not reveal my passwords to anyone.
- ! I will not arrange a face-to-face meeting with DJ School UK or anyone I meet online unless I have discussed this with my parents and/or DJ tutor and am accompanied by a trusted adult who will log in and log out the session.
- ! If I am concerned or upset about anything I see on the internet or any messages that I receive, I know I can talk to either:

- ! When I do take part in a face-to-face meeting with my DJ tutor I will:
- 1. Wear appropriate clothing and use appropriate language as if I was attending a public session.
- 2. Be ready on time with everything I need to do the lesson (DJ equipment, notebook, computer already running relevant software etc)
- 3. Set up my equipment and computer in an appropriate place, not my bedroom.



- 4. Have a parent/carer nearby so they can hear what is taking place in my lesson.
- 5. Make sure no compromising images or personal information is visible in the background of the room that I will be in as this could be filmed and recorded by accident in the lesson.

I understand that my internet use with DJ School UK will be recorded, monitored and logged. I understand that the recordings will be kept under DJ School UK's GDPR policy and that for more information I can see the DJ School UK Privacy notice which is available from the DJ School UK website here: <u>https://djschooluk.org.uk/policies/</u> I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if I choose not to follow them, DJ School UK may contact my parents/carers and/or have to stop my sessions.
